The Texas AgriLife Extension Agriculture committees in Bell, Bosque, Coryell, Falls, Hamilton, Limestone and McLennan County are sponsoring a Small Grain Tour on Friday, April 24, 2009 beginning at 9:00 a.m. in Huffman field off Highway 84 east of McGregor to view the demonstration plots, then moving to the McGregor Research Center for the rest of the program.

Speakers for the tour will be Dr. Gaylon Morgan, Texas AgriLife Extension Small Grain Specialist at College Station, Texas; Marty Jungman, Texas AgriLife Extension Entomologist in Hill/McLennan County. Farm Service Agency Program updates will be given by Mike Maedgen, McLennan County and George Melton, Coryell County.

Topics for the tour include wheat variety selection, oat variety selection, hands-on disease and insect management, weed control, fertility, marketing and forage production.
